

### KEY FINDINGS – APRIL '23 (COVERING MARCH '23 ACTIVITY)

- March visitation to Protected Natural Areas significantly increased since February (49% vs 44%). This follows a significant decline in February activity which coincided with Cyclone Gabrielle. Visitation to Protected Natural Areas is now on par with a year ago.
- Despite the number of people visiting PNAs and PHPs being the same as a year ago, they are visiting less frequently the average number of visits to Protected Natural Areas and Protected Heritage Places in the last month (March '23) is lower compared to a year ago.
- Satisfaction with the overall experience at Protected Natural Areas remained stable this month and also when compared to a year ago.
- Satisfaction with the overall experience at Protected Heritage Places remained stable this
  month despite a significant drop in those rating their experience as good when compared to
  a year ago.
- More people said that their visit to a Protected Heritage Place was emotionally uplifting and meaningful, now in line with levels seen last year. The same also applies to the number of people saying their visit was one of the best ever had.
- NPS for both Protected Natural Areas and Protected Heritage Places remains lower than a
  year ago. Protected Natural Areas NPS is 28, following a significant decrease last month.
  Protected Heritage Places NPS is 12. A year ago these were 34 and 23, respectively.
- The number of people who strongly agree that their Protected Natural Area of personal importance to them is damaged by visitors has increased.


















Q12b: Thinking about your most recent visit to <LOCATION SELECTED IN Q8>, what, if any information sources did you use to help plan for a successful trip?



Q15: Overall, how would you rate your experience at <LOCATION SELECTED IN Q8>?



#### **Satisfaction with Protected Natural Areas: Facilities**





#### Satisfaction with Protected Natural Areas: Signage and Maintenance






Q14b: Still thinking about your most recent visit to <LOCATION SELECTED IN Q8>, how much do you agree or disagree with each of the statements below?



Q27: Overall, how would you rate your experience at <LOCATION SELECTED IN Q20>?



#### Satisfaction with Protected Heritage Places: Facilities











Q16: How LIKELY is it you would RECOMMEND < LOCATION SELECTED IN Q8> to your family or friends?













#### "This Protected Natural Area is damaged by the activities resulting from these visitors"









#### Agreement that visitors weaken local traditions & cultures remains unchanged.










